

Murphy Meets with FAA to Press for Waterbury-Oxford Airport Area Homeowners Needs

WASHINGTON, D.C. - This morning, Congressman Chris Murphy (CT-5) met with representatives from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) about the needs of the homeowners who live in the immediate area around Waterbury-Oxford Airport and desire to have their noise and safety concerns addressed.

"My meeting with the FAA this morning was productive. They got the message I was sending, which was that the homeowners need them to act quickly and provide options concerning their homes and their future housing needs," said Murphy.

The FAA confirmed that they can provide assistance as soon as the Connecticut Department of Transportation completes its noise study. Murphy pressed the FAA to ensure that the federal process is clear to residents and provides adequate compensation and flexibility for homeowners.

"I'm going to push every player in this situation to work as quickly as possible for the homeowners' sakes. There is no reason why we shouldn't all be working our hardest to resolve this without further delay," said Murphy.
