Chris and Janice Smolinski, mother of Billy Smolinski, who went missing in Waterbury on August 24, 2004 at the age of 31, testified in Washington at a Judiciary Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism and Homeland Security hearing about "Billy's Law." Murphy introduced this federal legislation, named after Billy Smolinski, along with Congressman Ted Poe (R-TX) to help families find missing loved ones.
